A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, nearly 20,000 participants and attendees from across the state of North Carolina connect annually in Raleigh to make their communities better through friendship with their multicultural neighbors;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ROY COOPER, Governor of the State of North Carolina, do hereby proclaim October, 2017, as "**INTERNATIONAL DIVERSITY MONTH**" in North Carolina, and commend its observance to all citizens.
